Total Transit Set to Operate Non-Emergent Medical Transportation in Colorado

Contract began Nov. 1, Servicing Nine Counties Throughout Northern Colorado

PHOENIX (Nov. 6, 2014)—Total Transit, headquartered in Glendale, Ariz., has recently contracted with 55 transportation companies that will serve Colorado Medicaid members by providing Non-Emergent Medical Transportation that began on Saturday, Nov. 1.
